

Privacy statement for Inreda information and study participation requests

1. Introduction

In this privacy statement Inreda Diabetic B.V. (hereinafter referred to as: 'Inreda') will give you information about how we collect your personal data and how we manage them. In this document, we will inform you where we store your data and for what purpose. In addition, we will inform you about your rights and how to act in case you want to exercise these rights.

2. Company information

3. Purpose

Inreda processes your personal data for the following purposes:

- participation in a meeting/congress;
- providing information about the progress of the development and results of the Inreda AP®;
- to provide information if you are interested in participating in a study of the Inreda AP®.

We then need your data to check whether your data meets the study criteria and to inform you about (participation in) (future) studies. Your data will never be transferred or shared with third parties without your permission.

4. Legal basis

Inreda processes your personal data under the legal basis of 'consent'. If you have indicated that you would like to be kept informed of the latest developments and results of the Inreda AP® and/or you register to participate in a future study /project/meeting or congress, by agreeing to this privacy statement on the input screen of our website or when registering and entering your details, you give Inreda permission to store your personal data in accordance with this privacy statement.

5. Personal data

Inreda®

Our website does not intend to collect data about website visitors who are younger than 16 years, unless they have permission from their parent(s) or guardian. However, we cannot check whether a visitor is 16 years or older.

6. Data recipients

The personal data that Inreda receives and processes is managed in our Customer Relationship Management (CRM) system.

7. Storage period

Inreda does not store your personal data longer than is necessary to achieve the purposes for which your data is collected. The personal data will be deleted after the basis on which the data was collected is no longer valid. You can exercise your rights and have the data deleted earlier.

8. Security

Inreda does not make physical copies of your data, they are only stored in our CRM system. Our CRM system is only accessible with a login name and password and logging in at a new location is only possible with two-step verification. The website is secured via an SSL certificate and various firewalls. Only authorized persons have access to change the website and this is encrypted via complex passwords.

9. Your rights

- Right to see your data

You have the right to see the data that is stored from you in our CRM system at all times.

- Right to rectify and remove your data

If data is not correct or has been changed, you have the right to rectify these data. In case you decide that the data should no longer be stored, you have the right to ask for removal at all times.

- Right to object

You have the right to object against the usage of your data by Inreda.

- Right to transfer your data

You can request Inreda to send your information as a computer file to you or to a third party defined by you.

- Right to complaint

You have the right to file a complaint with the Dutch Data Protection Authority via this <u>link</u> if you believe that Inreda Diabetic is not handling your data correctly.

You can exercise these rights by sending an email to <u>privacy@inredadiabetic.nl</u>. To ensure that the request for access has been made by you, we ask you to enclose a copy of your passport. Make your passport photo, MRZ (machine readable zone, the strip with numbers at the bottom of the passport), passport number and Citizen Service Number (BSN) black in this copy to protect your privacy.
